



INVITATION

The Boxing Club "Olimp", together with the Olaine Sports Center, cordially invites your team to participate in the 18th International Boxing Tournament “**Olaines Kauss 2026**”, which will take place from September 17th to September 20th, 2026, in Olaine, Latvia.

1. GOALS AND OBJECTIVES OF THE EVENT:

- Promote youth boxing and a healthy lifestyle;
- Foster international friendship and sports exchange;
- Develop young boxing talents;
- Cultivate sportsmanship and fair play;
- Strengthen relationships between clubs and regional communities;
- Raise the prestige of boxing in Latvia.

2. AGE AND CLASSIFICATION

Youth	2008-2009	55 kg, 60 kg, 65 kg, 70 kg, 75 kg, 80 kg, 85 kg, 90 kg
Elite	2007 and older	85 kg, 90+ kg

Note: The maximum number of participants in each weight category is 8 boxers.

If the number of entries exceeds this limit, participants will be divided into subgroups with separate medal sets.

3. REQUIREMENTS AND RULES

- **Participant Documentation & Equipment:** All boxers must bring a valid National Passport and an International Boxing Record Book.
- **Uniform:** Two sets of competition uniforms matching the corner colors (red and blue).
- **Protective Gear:** Headguard, mouthguard (gumshield), and groin protector.
- **Team Flags:** Each team leader must bring their national flag.
- **Rules & Regulations:** The tournament will be held in accordance with current World Boxing rules.
- **Scoring System:** The official 10-Point Must Scoring System will be used for all bouts.

- **Referees & Judges (R&Js):**

- All active referees and judges must hold a valid national or international R&J license recognized by their respective National Federation.
- Participating teams are strongly encouraged to bring qualified R&Js to ensure high-quality and neutral officiating.

Anti-Doping: The tournament strictly complies with and supports the WADA Anti-Doping Code.

5. ACCOMMODATION AND TRANSFER FOR PARTICIPANTS

- **Event Financing:** Boxing Club “Olimp” and the Olaine Municipality cover all organizational expenses related to the competition.
- **Participation Fee:** 20 EUR per boxer (for teams arranging their own accommodation).
- **Accommodation & Meal Package:** The organizers offer a package for 180 EUR per person.
- **Package includes:**
 - Hotel accommodation (3 nights);
 - Full board meals (breakfast, lunch, and dinner);
 - Participation fee;
 - Transfers between the official hotel and the competition venue.

- **Final Entries** (with confirmed team composition, arrival, and departure details): Must be submitted by August 30th, 2026.
